I hope that this email finds you well and staying warm. **School will be Open tomorrow, January 17th, 2024.** The temperatures are forecast to be increasing from the morning and throughout the day and the Winter Weather Warning has been decreased to a Winter Weather Advisory. We have confirmed with our Transportation Partner that our Buses will be running on-time and we will confirm this detail with them early tomorrow morning as the intense cold has had a negative impact on automotive batteries.

**While the increase in temperature makes school travel safer, the low temperatures continue to present challenges. Please dress accordingly.
